

**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT
EVANSVILLE REGIONAL AIRPORT
APPLICATION FOR PASSENGER FACILITY CHARGE**

Date of Publication: December 19, 2025

The Evansville-Vanderburgh Airport Authority District (Airport Authority) located in Evansville, Indiana, is providing opportunity for public comment until January 19, 2026 related to the proposed Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) Application Numbers 5 & 6. This written, public notice is provided in accordance with the requirements contained in Federal Aviation Regulations (CFR) Part 158.24 Passenger Facility Charges.

The Airport Authority plans to implement a PFC of \$4.50 per enplaned passenger. We anticipate collection to begin on February 1, 2026 and continue to June 1, 2040. The total revenue to be collected is \$14,657,793.20.

In accordance with Part 158.11 and 158.23(a)(3), the Airport Authority, plans to exempt non-scheduled Part 135 carriers and on-demand air carriers from collecting a PFC. During calendar year 2024, these classes of carriers reported 584 enplanements out of a total of 189,122.

Application 5 Project 1) Snow Removal Equipment Facility Building This project involved the construction of a dedicated Snow Removal Equipment (SRE) Building to house and maintain critical airfield snow removal vehicles and equipment.

Project Cost: \$15,008,111

PFC Share: \$13,627,365.79

Application 6 Project 1) West Ramp Reconstruction. The Terminal Renovation Project modernized the airport terminal to improve passenger experience, operational efficiency, and safety.

Project Cost: \$13,834,130.69

PFC Share: \$691,706.53

Application 6 Project 2) Terminal Renovation The West Ramp Reconstruction Project rehabilitated and expanded the airport's west aircraft ramp to improve safety, operational efficiency, and accommodate current and future aircraft activity.

Project Costs: \$6,774,417.56

PFC Share: \$338,720.88

Funding Status: These projects have been completed. The SRE Building costs were paid directly by the Airport Authority and will be reimbursed at 90.80%, which reflects the eligible percentage under this application. For the West Ramp Reconstruction and Terminal Renovation projects, funded through AIP Grants, the Airport Authority contributed 5% of the total costs. That amount will also be reimbursed through this application.

Total Project Cost: \$35,616,659.25

PFC Share: \$14,657,793.20
